DETAILS ON THE MOBILITY OF GOODS, VEHICLES AND DRIVERS

Lonato del Garda, 9th March 2020

The Italian Government has taken restrictive measures that involve the whole country. However, Feralpi would like to underline that its production and logistics activities continue normally in all the companies of the Group. This includes activities of loading and unloading goods of national or international origin or destination, giving continuity to normal operations in compliance with the Government Decree.

In fact, with the aim of guaranteeing continuity to all economic, production and work activities, the Authorities have chosen to apply a series of exemptions for "proven working needs".

We therefore reassure that the activities in our factories will continue and will do so according to the measures indicated and allowed in the Ministerial Decree, adopting the appropriate precautionary measures with scrupulous control activities at the production mills entrance, with the aim of protecting health.

In particular, the Feralpi Group - while inviting a sense of responsibility - informs that, with reference to the Decree of the President of the Council of Ministers of 8 March 2020

:

- **TRANSPORT OF GOODS AND VEHICLES**

- The transport of goods is regarded as a work requirement, therefore allowed.
- **Goods are allowed to enter and leave the territories concerned.**

- **DRIVERS**

- Drivers **may enter and leave the territories concerned and move within them.**
- The movement is **limited to the needs of delivery or pick-up of the goods.**

- **COMING FROM MUNICIPALITIES, REGIONS OR NATIONS OUTSIDE THE FERALPI GROUP'S PREMISES**

- **Travel is not prohibited for proven business/work reasons.**
- **Unless they are subject to quarantine or have tested positive for the virus,** cross-border commuters will be able to enter and leave the territories concerned to reach their place of work and return home.
